**Acute Beds**      924,107 (total U.S. staffed beds, all hospitals)

**ICU Beds**      46,500 (general ICU beds)

Plus, approx. 45,000 additional ICU beds

**ICU Staffing**      28,808 intensivists (w/ ICU privileges in US acute hospitals)
